- visiting schools, carrer expos and Szeged festival ;)





Located 160 km from Budapest, Szeged is a regional centre in the South Plain Region of Hungary, and the third biggest town of the country with approximately 160,000 inhabitants. It is often referred to as The City of Sunshine in Hungary, as on average, it receives the biggest number of sunlit hours a year (but don't be surprised from the snow in winter...)

Szeged offers a lot of places like museums, cinemas and pubs, and the vibrant

atmosphere attracts more and more tourists every summer.

The University of Szeged is among the best in the country, and with its 30,000 students, it contributes significantly to Szeged's lovely, intercultural and youthful picture.
